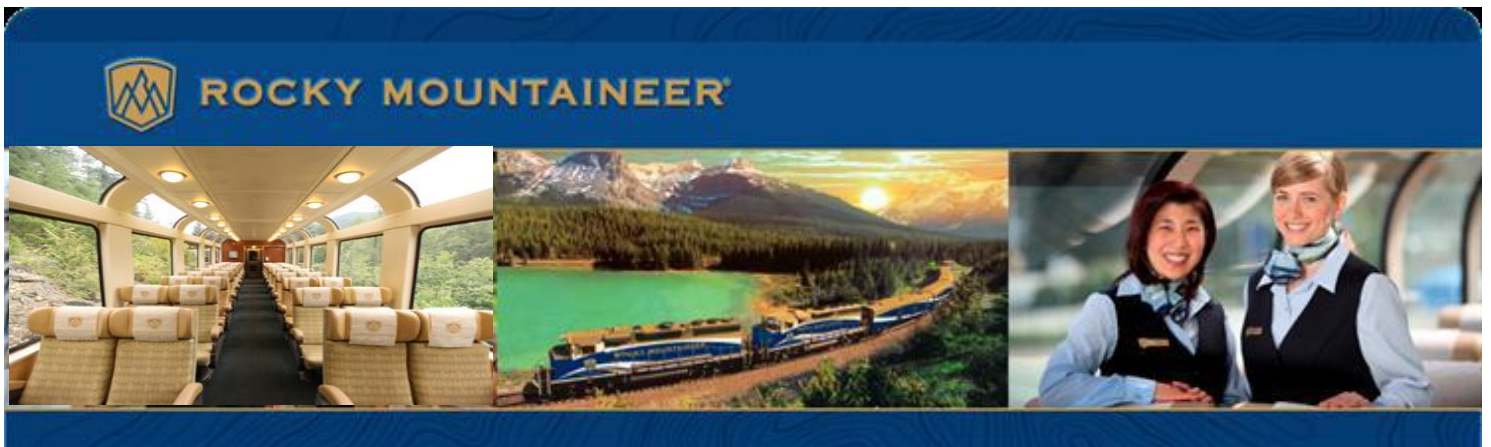
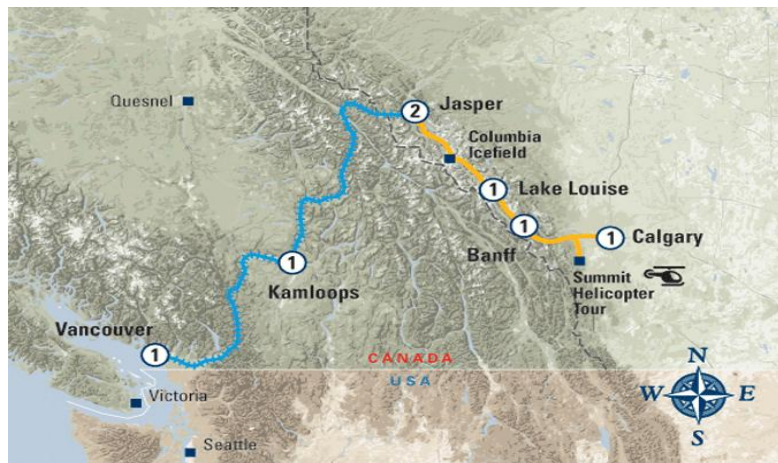

Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1

Calgary Arrival & Transfer to Hotel

Calgary Arrival & Transfer to your hotel in downtown Calgary. Spend the rest of the day sightseeing in the Stampede City independently. Welcome Dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Calgary. (D)

Day 2

Calgary to Banff

Breakfast included at the hotel.

Depart Calgary this morning for a tour to Banff. Highlights include Bow Falls, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos. Banff Gondola is included. Your tour ends on arrival in Banff this afternoon. Overnight in Banff. (B)

Day 3

Banff to Lake Louise & Yoho National Park.

Breakfast included at your hotel.

Board your motor coach for a tour through Yoho National Park viewing some of its magnificent natural wonders en route to Lake Louise. Among the points of interest are the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. After checking in at Chateau Lake Louise, the remainder of the afternoon will be at your leisure to explore the breathtaking surroundings of the famous Lake Louise. Overnight at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. B

Day 4

Lake Louise to Jasper via Icefields Parkway

Breakfast included at your hotel.

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Banff and Jasper National Parks via the Icefields Parkway. Among the highlights are Bow Lake, the Columbia Icefield and Athabasca Falls. The Columbia Icefield is one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle and one of the most accessible icefields in North America. Here you will ride on an Ice Explorer to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier to learn more about its geological features. Time will be available for lunch on your own at the Icefields Chalet. Arrive in Jasper late this afternoon. Overnight in Jasper. B

Day 5

Jasper Highlights Sightseeing Tour

Breakfast included at your hotel.

This morning, board your motorcoach for a sightseeing tour of Jasper including many natural attractions and rugged peaks, and perhaps you'll even catch a glimpse of some of the creatures that call this mountain park home. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore more of Jasper at your leisure. Overnight in Jasper. B

Day 6

Rocky Mountaineer - Jasper to Kamloops

Board your motorcoach and transfer to the Jasper Station. Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from Jasper in the Canadian Rockies to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. As you journey west and south you will be surrounded by the dramatic scenery of the Continental Divide and by the river valleys of the Monashee and Cariboo mountains. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, Pyramid Falls, the climb over Yellowhead Pass and the journey along the North Thompson River as you approach Kamloops. Overnight in Kamloops. B, L

Day 7

Rocky Mountaineer - Kamloops to Vancouver

Your journey continues west towards the Pacific Ocean and the coastal city of Vancouver. On today's journey you will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. Upon arrival in Vancouver, board your motorcoach and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Vancouver. B, L

Day 8

Victoria Day Trip

Board a motorcoach for a full day tour to Victoria. The journey begins with a scenic 90 minute sailing aboard BC Ferries, travelling across the Strait of Georgia and past the Gulf Islands. You will visit world-famous Butchart Gardens, which is one of Canada's National Historic sites with 55 acres of breathtaking floral displays. Enjoy a beautiful drive through the lush farmland of the Saanich Peninsula as you make your way to Victoria. Highlights en route include the Inner Harbour, Beacon Hill Park, Parliament Buildings and The Fairmont Empress Hotel. Return to Vancouver in the evening. Enjoy a Farewell dinner at the hotel tonight. Overnight in Vancouver. B, D

Documentation: A U.S. passport valid for six months beyond your return date is required. Names on reservation for air and tour must match passport.

Not included: Airfare, optional travel insurance, Airline baggage fees, increases in security fees, taxes and fuel surcharges. Items of a personal nature such as liquor, laundry service, phone calls, beverages and meals not specified, spa services, and anything not specifically indicated as included. Tour pricing is based on a minimum of 15 participants.

Cancellation Policy: If you must cancel the following per person penalties apply. Without exception, all cancellations must be in writing to Viking Travel Service and are effective the date of receipt. Any unused portions of the tour are non-refundable. Insurance premiums are non-refundable.
